| 3a. Provides a rule or reasoning that links the evidence to the claim without merely repeating the claim and evidence. | |
| 3b. Reasoning explains how or why the evidence supports the claim. | |
| 3c. Reasoning is clearly stated (can be identified by the reader without inferring meaning). | |
| 3d. Reasoning includes a scientific concept or principle that links the claim and evidence. | |
| 3e. Reasoning is written in a complete sentence. | |
